FAMILY CAMP 2010

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No pets are permitted at camp.
2. Cars and vans must be parked in a designated parking area by the farm.
3. Campsite families may have a car at the camp-site.
4. Smoking only in designated areas.
5. If you are eating at camp, you must arrive at the beginning of the meal.
6. Bring your own first aid kit. A hospital is 4 miles from camp for emergencies.
7. Children cannot feed the animals.
8. Families can assist with feeding the animals escorted by a parent and 4-H staff member.
9. If you pet an animal, you must wash your hands.
10. Swimming is prohibited, unless we have a lifeguard on our beach.
11. You may fish off our property.
12. We recommend sneakers and socks due to the many tree branches, poison ivy and ticks at camp.
13. Classes such as ropes course, kayaking and canoeing require a pre-registration at the deadline to register.
14. The camp staff is not a baby sitting service; you are expected to escort your child to a class. You will be notified if your child acts up.
15. There will be classes for all ages.
16. No air conditioning or loud generators from the camp sites.
17. Cell phones are permitted, but not to distract from the general program.
18. Visitors must register and get a visitor's pass at office.
19. You will get a name tag for the weekend, and are asked to wear it.
20. Families might be asked to eat with others depending on the size of the group.
21. Professionals will maintain the washhouses, but you are asked to keep it clean.
22. You must bring your own bedding. Mattresses have a waterproof cover. They are cot size, but twin sheets will work.
23. No open flames, lanterns, etc. in the cabin area.
24. We will have a campfire, so come with a song or skit to participate.
25. Camp office number is 631 727-6065; Friday through Monday during Family Camp Weekend.
26. Other classes will be announced at the camp weekend registration on Friday evening.
27. Illegal drugs are not permitted.
28. Those not eating with the camp must supply their own ice chest. Camp does not supply the ice.
